Council Directive 89/106/EEC of 21 December 1988 on the mutual adjustment of the legal and administrative provisions of the formal issue for intended for construction products, amended by Directive 93/68/EEC, adopted on 22 July 1993

Scope (Articles 1, 2 and 3)

This Regulation determines the conditions for the placing or making available on the market construction products by establishing harmonized rules on how the performance of construction products with regard to their essential characteristics, and for the use of the CE marking on the products.

For the purposes of this regulation:

- 'construction product': any product or kit that is manufactured and marketed for to be permanently incorporated into structures or parts thereof, and the performance of which affect the performance of the structure with regard to the fundamental requirements for construction works;
- 'kit': a construction product marketed by one manufacturer with at least ten two components that must be combined to be incorporated into the structure are processed;
- 'construction works': architectural and civil engineering works;
- 'performance of a construction product': the performance with regard to the essential characteristics, expressed in level or class or in a descriptive manner.
